

HERE ARE SOME TIPS FOR GETTING A GOOD RECORDING




KNOW YOUR EQUIPMENT (PRACTICE BEFORE YOU GO INTO THE FIELD)



DON'T MOVE YOUR HAND ON THE RECORDER




THE SPEAKER'S MOUTH. HOLD IT OFF TO ONE SIDE TO AVOID NOISY "P" SOUNDS.




PLACES. (ALTHOUGH SOMETIMES NOISY BACKGROUNDS CAN BE INTERESTING).
